


The future State Highway (1934) – then Bridgeway (1936)

#### JOSEPH V. SILVA 1855 - 1914

#### Important Facts:

- Joseph (whose given name was originally José).
   was born in 1855 on the island of 5ão Jorge (St. George), one of the nine Azores Islands in the Atlantic Ocean that are part of Portugal.
- He came to California in approximately 1873 when he was 18 years old.
- In 1877 he took over the management of the Big Coyote Dairy that was located in Tam Valley on the road to Muir Beach. He worked there with Joseph Peters, another immigrant from the Azores.
- \* He later moved into Sausalito where he and Peters became partners in a grocery store on Caledonia Street between Johnson and Pine. The store was on the ground floor, and Joseph and his family lived upstairs.
- As can be seen from the photos at the top of the page, the building in which the Silva & Peters store was located still exists with very few changes. Today the Caledonia Street Barber Shop and Café DiVino are on the ground floor.

\* Joseph's son, Manuel (who went by "Sam"), also became a successful businessman. He owned both a large dairy near Rodeo Lagoon in the Marin Headlands, and a men's clothing store on Bridgeway.

#### Contributions of Joseph Silva:

- \* He became one of the leaders of the Portuguese-American community that at one point constituted approximately one-quarter of Sausalito's population. He served for over 10 years as the President of the IDESST, Sausalito's most important Portuguese organization. His son, Sam, also later served as IDESST President.
- He played an important role in Sausalito's incorporation as a city in 1893, and served both as a member of the Sausalito Board of Trustees, and as Sausalito's Treasurer.
- He was a Founder and Director of the Bank of Sausalito.

#### An Interesting Story:

Joseph passed away late in 1913. The following, taken from a report on his funeral that appeared in

the January 3, 1914 Sousolito News, shows the high esteem in which he was held both in Sausalito and throughout the state:

> "The funeral of Joseph V. Silva, ex-town trustee and ex-town treasurer of Sausalito, held on last Saturday morning, was the largest ever held in Southern Marin and would have been much larger only for the threatening weather. Representative. citizens from all sections of California came to pay their last respects to their true friend..... Hundreds of people viewed his remains at his late home on Caledonia Street.... The remains were carried from his late home through a long line of members and friends and beneath an arch formed by an immense U.S. flag at the head of one line, and an immense Portuguese flag at the head of the opposite line .... The remains were laid to rest in Fernwood cemetery, the site being within view of his ranch of 37 years ago ... "

## Chapter 5.20 MINIATURE GOLF COURSES

#### 5.20.020 License - Required.

It is unlawful for any person, as proprietor, agent, manager, owner or otherwise, to carry on, or conduct, the business of operating a **public miniature golf course**, in any place in the City for gain, either by direct charge, or by a club membership plan, or by any other indirect means whereby a charge is made, without first having obtained a permit and license to do so, as provided in this chapter, and complying with all the regulations and requirements contained in this chapter. [Ord. 315 § 2, 1930.]
